Knight & Knight-Banneret by Edward 4.
for his services at the Battle of Northampton
Fought on behalf of the Victorious House of York
A.D. 1460.
The above Sir William must have been a descendant of
the 1st Banneret

II. Edward
a lineal descendant of the above
Sir William as the date excludes Edward from
being the son of the Sir William 1st Banneret 1460.
The House & Estate viz Crayford House, alias Stone Hall, Parish of Great
Mongeham Kent descended to him, Edward, from Sir William Crayford
a Marble Monument in Great Mongeham Church St. Martin's record recd
A.D. 1615. 1739. "In the North Chancel a monument having the figure of a man
in Armour, & his wife kneeling at an Altar & underneath the figure sons & one
daughter, son Edward Crayford, Esq. eldest son of Sir William Crayford, Esq. 1615."
Asted. His. Kent. vol. IX. P. 575. he bore for his Arms "Or, on a Chevron, Sable, three Eagles heads erased, Argent."

he was the last of the family who resided
at Crayford House. the greater part of his
Estate was left by Will to his widow
Ursula. instead of to Edward son of George
his next brother. (The mansion was pulled down by Mr. Rand)
& his 4 other Estates he left by will to Ursula. she
married again Richard Rand who had two daughters by him
one married Robt Chadwick Esq. of Northfleet. the other became
possessed of this Estate on her mother's decease & afterwards it to
her eldest daughter Mrs W. Mrs. vice of Botschangers.
