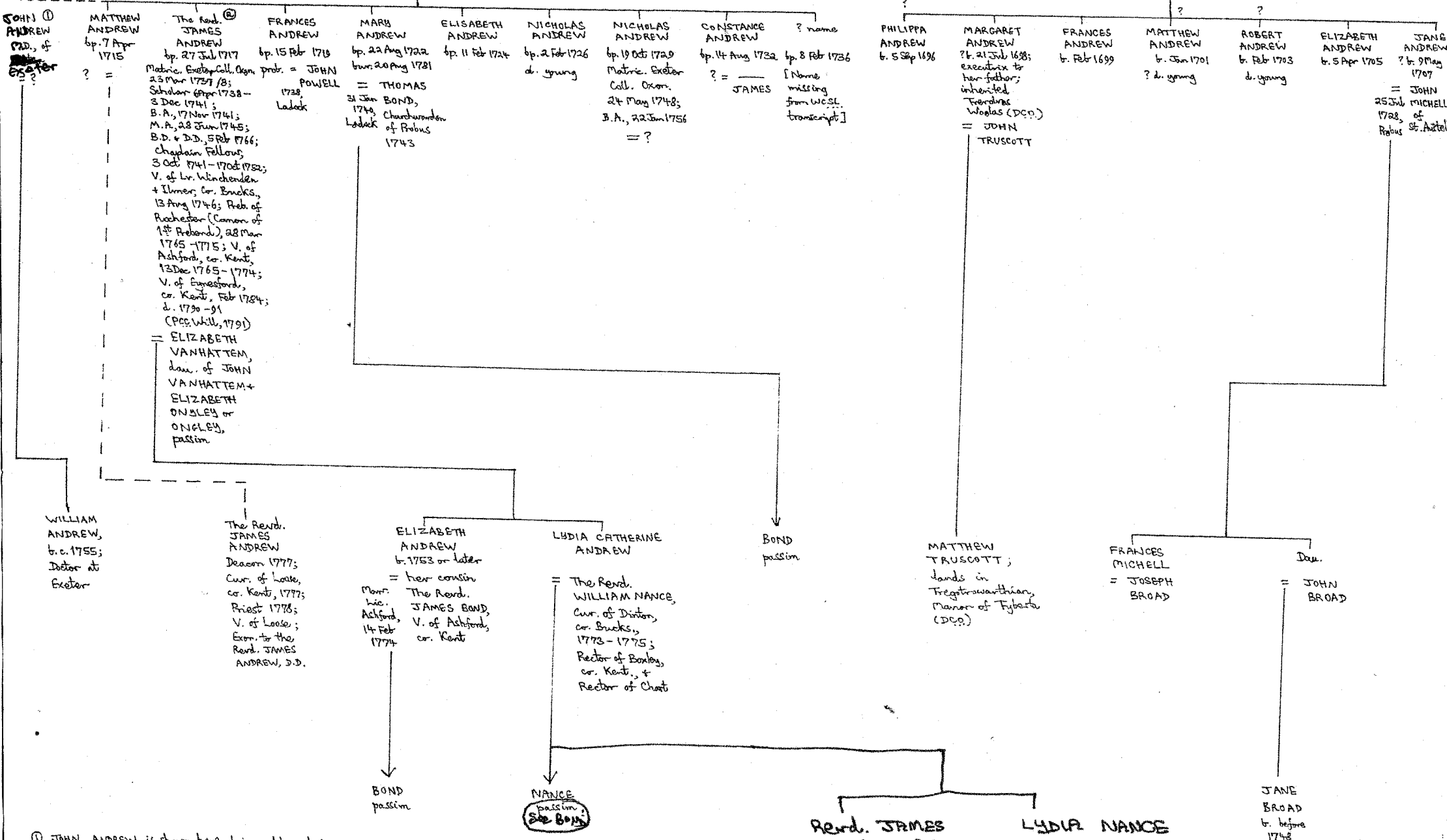

① JOHN ANDREW is shown here, being addressed in a letter of JAMES ANDREW DD, as "My dear brother Doctor". He is perhaps more likely the son of JOHN ANDREW of St. Em, co. Cornwall (see *Alumni Oxonienses*), who graduated B.A. 1731, M.A. 1734, B.M. 1739/40, + D.M. 1742/43.

② R. Aluoke (*The History of Cornwall*, Vol. v, p. 67, 1206) says he "was singularly kind to his relations; resigning several pieces of preferment, in favour of nephews or cousins, whose education he had superintended". Few of these relations can at present be identified.
