DECLARATION

I Thomas Bartter of Tilmanstone in the county of Kent farmer do solemly and sincerely declare that William Bartter, late of Tilmanstone aforesaid shopkeeper deceased departed this life in 1819 leaving Mrs. Mary Bartter his widow and also eight children viz William Bartter, George Bartter, me the said Thomas Bartter, John Bartter, Stephen Barter, Charles Cricket Bartter, Bradley Bartter and June Bartter him surviving and I do declare that the said Mary Bartter departed this life in 1822 and that at the time of the execution of certain Indentures of Lease and Release dated 18th and 19th October 1827 between the said William Bartter ( the son ) of the first part and the said Thomas Bartter and Martha my wife and Slodden Castle and William Drayson of the second part and the said John Bartter of the third part and the said Stephen Bartter and Sarah his wife of the fourth part and the said Jane Bartter of the fifth part and the said Charles Bartter of the sixth part and the said Bradley Bartter of the seventh part and the said George Bartter and Susannah his wife of the eighth part and Thomas West of the ninth part ... they the said William, John, Charles Cricket and Bradley Bartter ... were all of them unmarried, and I make solemn declaration ... that this is true...
